The State Planning Office, Code Enforcement Officer Training and Certification program will sponsor basic training in the commercial energy code in the building standards specific area. Michael Lessard from Kennebec Valley Community College will be presenting these workshops. Issues covered include, but are not limited to: the statutory requirements of the Maine Uniform Building and Energy Code, code purposes and organization, applicable state laws, review and permitting, methods of compliance in accordance with the IECC, ASHRAE 90.1 and the IEBC, and inspection and enforcement techniques. **Attendees should bring the 2009 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC) and ASHRAE Standard 90.1-2007 to the training session.** Copies of the code will not be available for purchase at the training.

Please note: This is basic training geared toward individuals preparing to sit for certification exams. In the new CEO Training and Certification rule this basic training is mandatory for third-party inspector certification and CEO recertification in the building standards specific area.

Fundamentals of Building Science

This course will provide an overview of energy movement in buildings, surface and air transported heat loss, R and U values, indoor air quality, the building envelope and rules, insulating and air sealing, blower doors, infrared imaging and weatherization quality control techniques.
